WYEREAS, educating the public and health care providers about the importance of a healthy lifestyle and early detection of male health problems will result in reducing rates of mortality from disease; and

WYEREAS, men who are educated about the value of preventative health can play a part in prolonging their lifespan and their role as productive family members will be more likely to participate in health screenings; and

WYEREAS, fathers who maintain a healthy lifestyle are role models for their children and have happier, healthier children; and

WYEREAS, Men's Health Network worked with Congress to develop Men's Health week as a special campaign to help educate men, boys, and their families about the importance of positive health attitudes and preventative health practices; and

WYEREAS, the Men's Health Website has been established at <a href="www.MensHealthMonth.org">www.MensHealthMonth.org</a> and features resources, proclamations, and information about awareness events and activities, including Wear Blue for Men's Health; and

WYEREAS, Lenoir City Men's Health Month will focus on a broad range of men's health issues, including heart disease, diabetes, mental health, prostate, testicular, and colon cancer, and citizens are encouraged to increase awareness of the importance of a healthy lifestyle, regular exercise, and medical check-ups.

**Now, Therefore** I, Tony R. Aikens, Mayor of the City of Lenoir City, do hereby **Proclaim** the month of June 2022 as Men's Health Month in Lenoir City, Tennessee, and encourage all our citizens to pursue preventative health practices and early detection efforts.
