WHEREAS, Men's Health Month provides an opportunity to educate and focus on a broad range of men's health issues, including prostate, testicular and bladder cancer, heart disease, mental health, sexual and reproductive health, diabetes, colon cancer, tobacco and alcohol use, and substance abuse; and

WHEREAS, educating men about the value preventative health screenings can play in prolonging their life; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of Arizona are encouraged to increase awareness of the importance of a healthy lifestyle, regular exercise and medical check-ups.
