WHEREAS, educating the public and health care providers about the importance of a healthy lifestyle and early detection of male health problems will result in reducing rates of mortality from disease; and

WHEREAS, men, boys and their families should learn the importance of positive health attitudes and preventative health practices and fathers who maintain a healthy lifestyle can be role models for their children; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I HONORABLE MARTY SMALL, SR., MAYOR of the Great City of Atlantic City, hereby recognize June as **MEN'S HEALTH MONTH** in Atlantic City, and encourage all our citizens to wear blue on June 17th and to pursue preventative health practices and early detection efforts throughout the year.
