RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING JUNE 9-15, 2025  
AS MEN'S HEALTH WEEK IN PREBLE COUNTY

**WHEREAS**, Men's Health Week is part of an ongoing international effort to educate men of all ages about receiving regular disease prevention screenings and living healthier lifestyles; and

**WHEREAS**, Men's Health Week was signed by President Bill Clinton, and became Public Law 103-264 on May 31, 1994, and has since been observed beginning the Monday prior to Father's Day annually; and

**WHEREAS**, Nationwide, life expectancy for men averages five years less than that of women, with men experiencing higher rates of health problems such as diabetes, obesity, cancer, heart disease, and premature mortality; and,

**WHEREAS**, The growing epidemic of suicide and substance abuse requires special effort to raise awareness of unrecognized and undiagnosed depression and mental stress in males; now therefore be it


